Limited Services

Juvenile Delinquency Clerk's Office will open Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. (lobby and phones) only accepting the following emergency filings:

- Detention Petition Hearings
- Priority Warrants/AWOL from placements
- JV-180- Request to Change Court Orders
- Psychotropic medication applications
- Emergency medical requests
- Petitions for re-entry of a non-minor dependent
- Petitions that require immediate response on health and safety
- Hearings on request for a warrant
- Probable cause for children who have not had a detention hearing
- Electronically submitted day and nighttime warrants

All other filings must be placed in the drop box located at the front entrance of the Juvenile Delinquency building.

Face coverings and social distancing required.

All Calendared Cases Resume

On June 1, the Juvenile Delinquency Court at San Bernardino and Victorville will resume all hearings with social distancing. Parties must check in with the Court and may be asked to wait outside until called. Parents or Guardians and the minor charged with an offense, and their attorneys, are the only parties allowed in each juvenile court location until further notice.
