GENERAL ORDER OF THE PRESIDING JUDGE

The purpose of this General Order is to promote fairness and justice where the amount of bail or fine for a traffic violation is incorrectly stated in the reminder notice for payment of the violation.

Effective immediately, when the amount of bail or fine stated in the reminder notice is less than the amount of bail or fine due pursuant to applicable law, the court shall order the defendant to pay the amount stated in the reminder notice and shall suspend payment of all bail or fines due in excess of the amount stated in the reminder notice.

If a defendant pays the bail or fine at the Clerk's Office counter, by phone or mail, or by web payment, the clerk shall accept the amount stated in the reminder notice, when it is less than the amount of bail or fine due pursuant to applicable law, as payment in full and shall suspend payment of all bail or fines due in excess of the amount stated in the reminder notice.

This order is effective January 1, 2024, and supersedes all previous general orders entitled *Incorrect Fine or Bail Amount in Reminder Notice*, issued by previous Presiding Judges. This order shall remain in effect until December 31, 2025.
