GENERAL ORDER OF THE PRESIDING JUDGE

Under California Rule of Court, Rule 3.1320(d), for good cause shown, a judge may order the hearing of a demurrer to be held on an earlier or later date, on notice prescribed by the judge.

When a party files a demurrer to an unlawful detainer case in any court of this county, and the filing party requests a hearing date more than 10 calendar days from the date of filing, the civil clerk shall submit the motion to the department that hears unlawful detainer cases to determine if there is good cause to either hold the hearing on an earlier or later date on notice prescribed by the court.

The hearing date will then be determined by the unlawful detainer department judicial officer, and shall be calendared accordingly.

This order is effective January 1, 2024, and supersedes all previous general orders entitled *Showing Good Cause to Shorten the Time to Hear Demurrers in*
